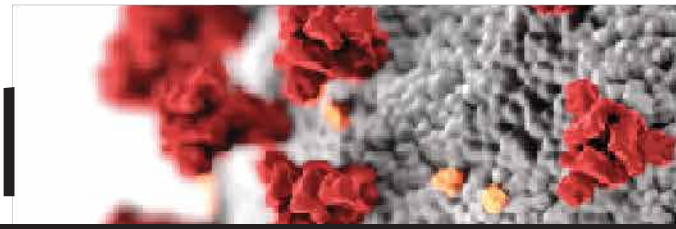

CDC's New Variants of Virus that Causes COVID-19

Statewide Conference Call Summary

We are continuing to see a decrease in spread throughout the State and the Nation, with Florida's RT value sitting at 0.9. We are also seeing a decrease in hospitalizations throughout the state.

Still monitoring the 3 new variants of COVID-19 from the UK, S. Africa, and Brazil. At this time, no variants from S. Africa or Brazil have been identified in the State of Florida, but we have seen cases of the UK variant. CDC is showing no evidence the variants escape the current vaccines, meaning the vaccine is effective against them. The CDC publishes new information weekly on these variants and that can be found on their website.

Mitigation measures such as mask wearing, handwashing, etc. remain important in combating the spread. It is also worth noting that this virus likes closed or tight spaces, so increasing ventilation in areas when possible is important for limiting spread.

Monoclonal therapeutics remain effective and most hospitals and facilities should have access to them.

Current vaccine allocations to the state are determined by the federal government on a week-to-week basis. If you received an allocation of first doses, the second doses will be automatically shipped to you.

In terms of adverse reactions, anaphylaxis reactions to the vaccine are very rare and are about 2 in every 2 million cases. However, please report these reactions along with any others as soon as possible to the FDA/CDC Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS).

Currently, we are seeing a decrease in hospitalizations in the state by about 20% in the past two weeks, as well as a decrease in long term care resident and staff cases, which is down close to 17% over the past two weeks.

ESS INFORMATION FOR REPORTING FACILITIES

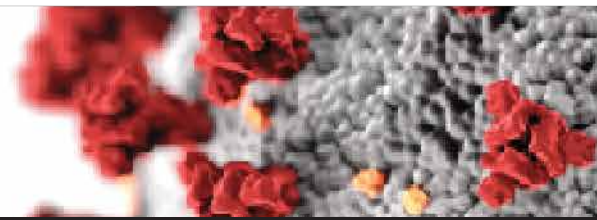
- ESS is critically important for the State to anticipate demand in the hospital & sub-acute care setting. This data influences decisions on the need for additional support and equipment requests from federal government.
- Facilities MUST verify and update data once daily.
- ESS is adding more fields daily. Instructions on these new fields available on the AHCA ESS website.
- Hospitals should estimate the number of med surge beds that can be converted to ICU beds. Do not duplicate bed numbers in different categories. Start with highest acuity beds.
- Corporate Representatives can be established to monitor data entry at individual facilities. Contact AHCA for assistance
