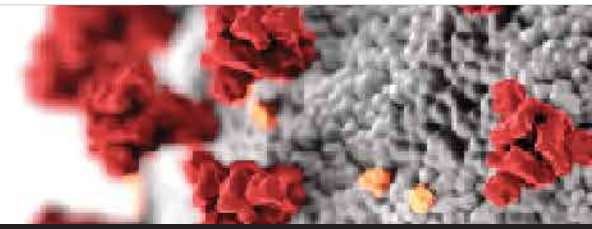

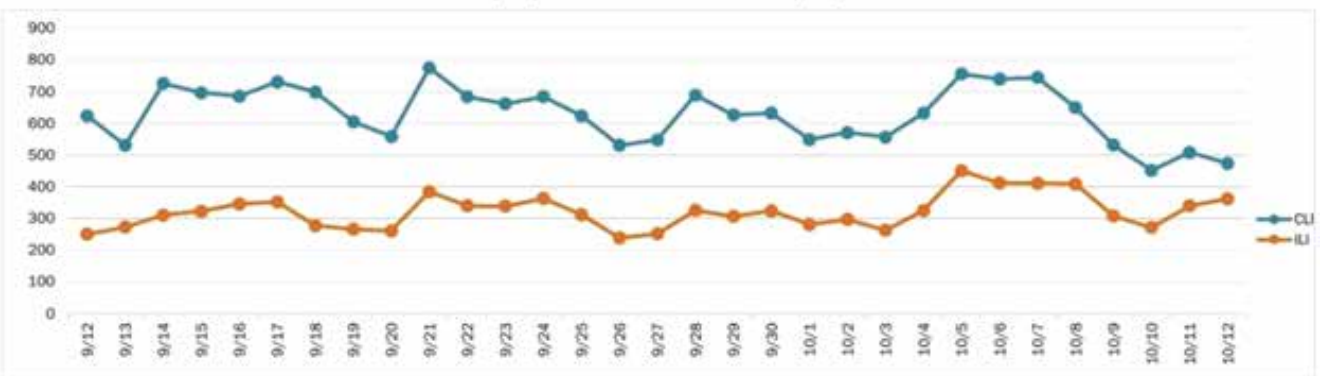

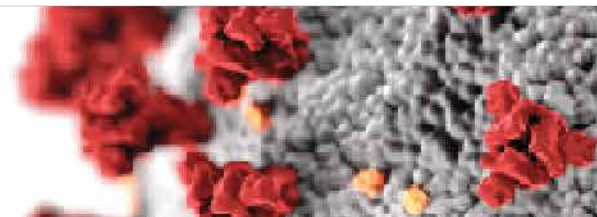

Statewide Conference Call Summary

- 4.76% positivity rate maintained over the past 2 weeks. Staying between 4 and 6%.
- COVID like illness have remained stable and are evening seeing slight declines throughout the state.
- RT Value 7-day average is 0.97.
- Nursing homes and ALF staff positivity numbers are low and continue to decline.
- 3 major testing modalities. PCR antigen and Antibody. Antibody will show if someone has been exposed to COVID in the past 2 weeks usually. All tests and their results need to be reported to DOH within 24 hours. PCR test remain to be the superior testing modality.
- Low levels of influenza within the state currently. but strongly encourage getting the flu vaccination. Pushing to have individuals vaccinated by end of October.
- Those who have delayed healthcare. it is important they get caught up on those routine healthcare visits.
- Consistently under 2500 hospitalizations statewide for the past 2 months.

ESS INFORMATION FOR REPORTING FACILITIES

- ESS is critically important for the State to anticipate demand in the hospital & sub-acute care setting. This data influences decisions on the need for additional support and equipment requests from federal government.
- Facilities MUST verify and update data once daily.
- ESS is adding more fields daily. Instructions on these new fields available on the AHCA ESS website.
- Hospitals should estimate the number of med surge beds that can be converted to ICU beds. Do not duplicate bed numbers in different categories. Start with highest acuity beds.
- Corporate Representatives can be established to monitor data entry at individual facilities. Contact AHCA for assistance
