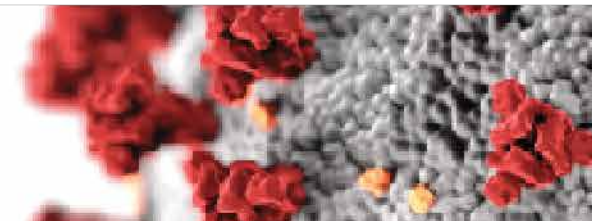

### Statewide Conference Call Summary

- We are seeing a decrease in the spread of COVID-19 in Florida, with the current RT value at 1.0. This is down from where it was last week.
- Although we are seeing increases in those vaccinated, please continue to follow mitigation measures and guidelines to help continue decreasing the spread.
- Currently in the State of Florida, more than 1 million individuals have received their first dose of the COVID-19 Vaccine. Of those, 65% are 65 years of age or older. This is good news as they are the most vulnerable population.
- For those facilities administering vaccines, please remember to report those within 24 hours to FL SHOTS. Future vaccine allocations will reference these numbers, so please make sure they are accurate.
- The second dose of vaccine allocations are starting to be delivered this week to facilities across the state. Note the vaccine cannot be administered sooner than 4 days than the required timeframe. There is no guidance on the maximum number of days between the first and second dose, but for both vaccines they should be separated by 20-21 days from the initial dosing.
- Along with the spread of COVID-19, we are seeing a slight decrease in hospitalizations over the last few days. Currently, there are 7,865 COVID-19 Hospitalizations and 20.21% of beds are available throughout the state.

## ESS INFORMATION FOR REPORTING FACILITIES

- ESS is critically important for the State to anticipate demand in the hospital & sub-acute care setting. This data influences decisions on the need for additional support and equipment requests from federal government.
- Facilities MUST verify and update data once daily.
- ESS is adding more fields daily. Instructions on these new fields available on the AHCA ESS website.
- Hospitals should estimate the number of med surge beds that can be converted to ICU beds. Do not duplicate bed numbers in different categories. Start with highest acuity beds.
- Corporate Representatives can be established to monitor data entry at individual facilities. Contact AHCA for assistance

### OVERVIEW OF COVID-19 VACCINATIONS IN FLORIDA

Total People Vaccinated 1,031,795

First Dose 938,537

Series Completed 93,258

First dose: received their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.  
Series Complete: received all recommended doses of the COVID-19 vaccine to be considered fully immunized.

Immunization Status 1,031,795

Up-to-date 893,481

Series Completed 93,258

Overdue 45,056

Immunization status: status of each person who has received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine.  
Up-to-date: describes those who have received their first dose and have not passed the recommended timeframe for their second dose.  
Overdue: describes those who have received their first dose and have passed the recommended timeframe to receive their second dose.  
Series complete: describes those who have received all recommended doses to be considered fully immunized.
